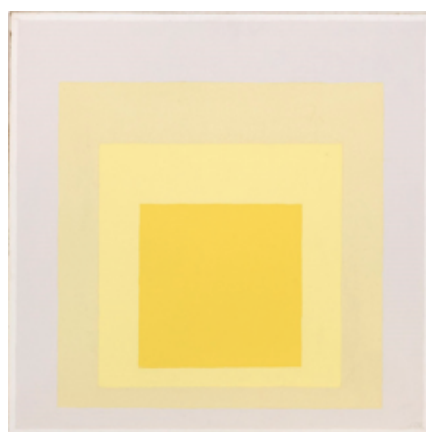

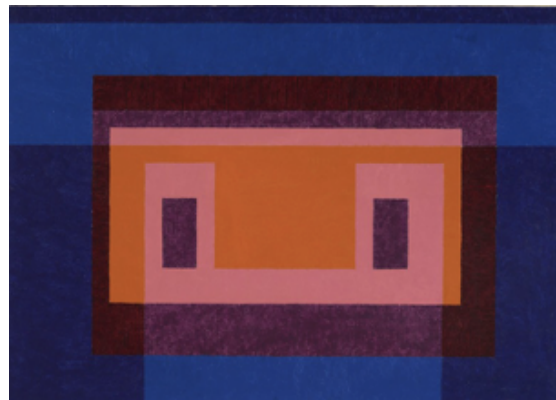
Red and Blue Layers, 1954

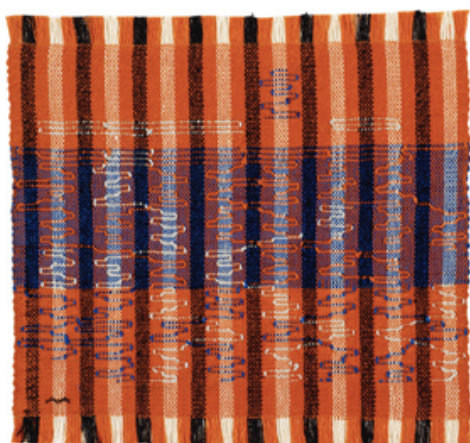
4 Central Warm Colors Surrounded by 2 Blues, 1948

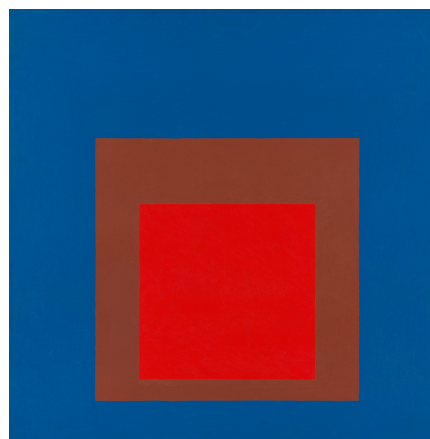

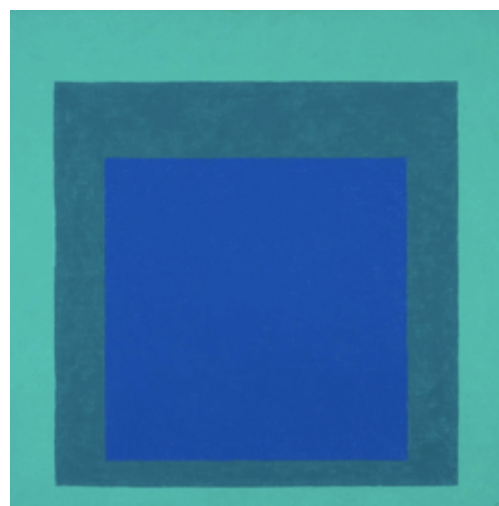

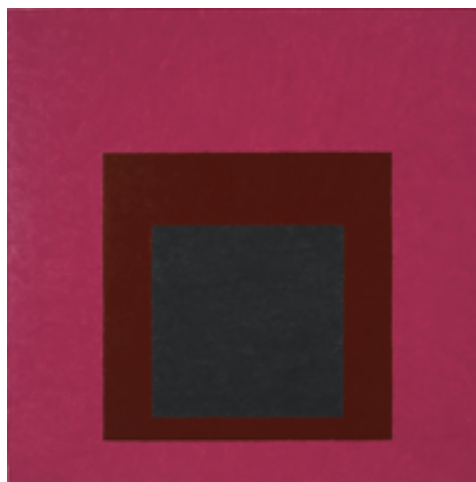

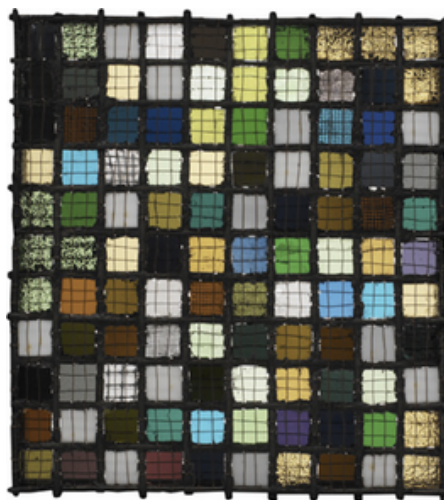

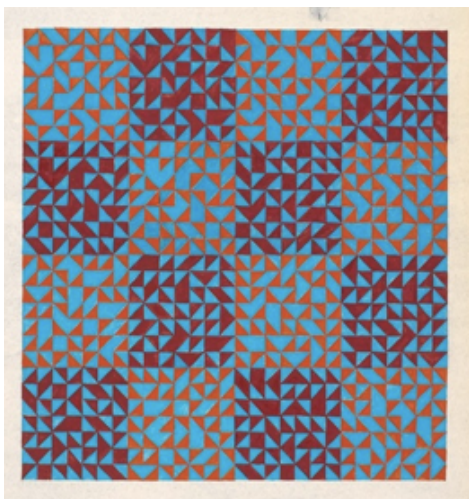
Gitterbild, vers 1921

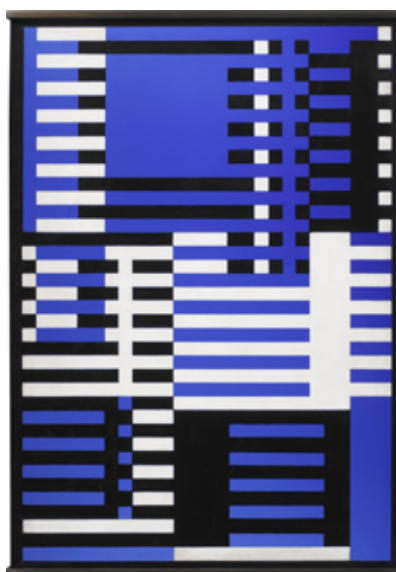
Color Study, 1970
